

Appendix I – The Timeline

Appendix I shows you the graphical timeline from Adam to Christ. The timeline starts with the year 4010 BC, and finishes with the year 191AD.

Each page in Appendix I contains a line chart that covers 200 years, people who live longer than 200 years are shown on as many pages as required to show the number of years that their life spanned. For example, Adam lived 950 years, so the bar that represents Adams life extends across four pages and the ends on the fifth page.

Each person is shown in a different colour, or in the black and white version, in a different shade of grey. This will make it easier to follow the life span of that person from one page to another. Each bar in the timeline is labelled with the persons name, this is repeated on every page that persons bar appears on. 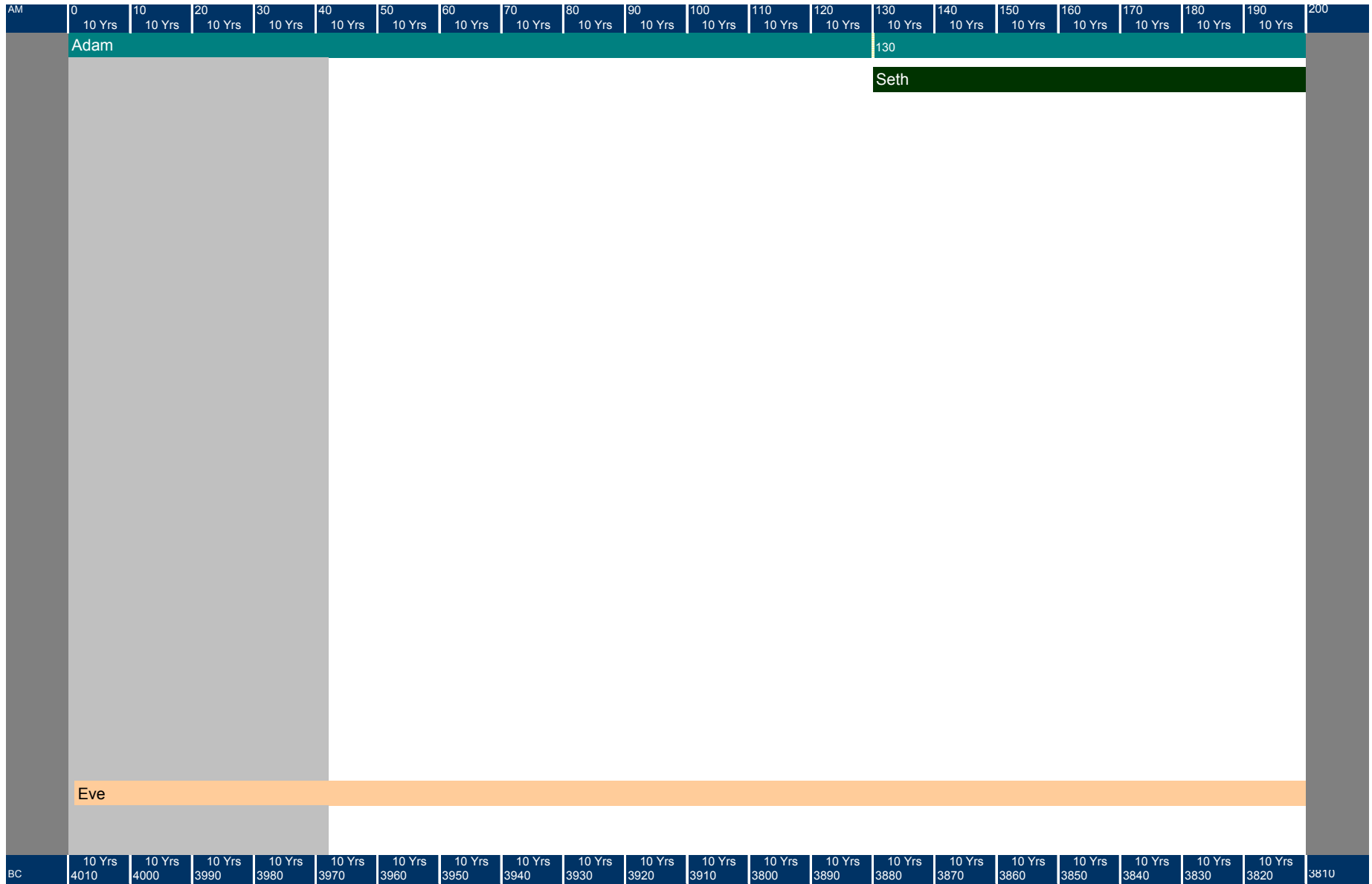
In general, each bar has a number at the end of it, indicating the total number of years that person lived. Some bars in the timeline have a vertical line part way along them with a number next to it, this indicates the persons age when their son or successor was born.

On some bars in the timeline you will find that instead of a number there is a question mark (?), this indicates that the person's age at this part of the timeline is unknown and the author has had to guess or estimate where that person's timeline should begin and end. You will find documentation for most of the question marks in the main body of the book.

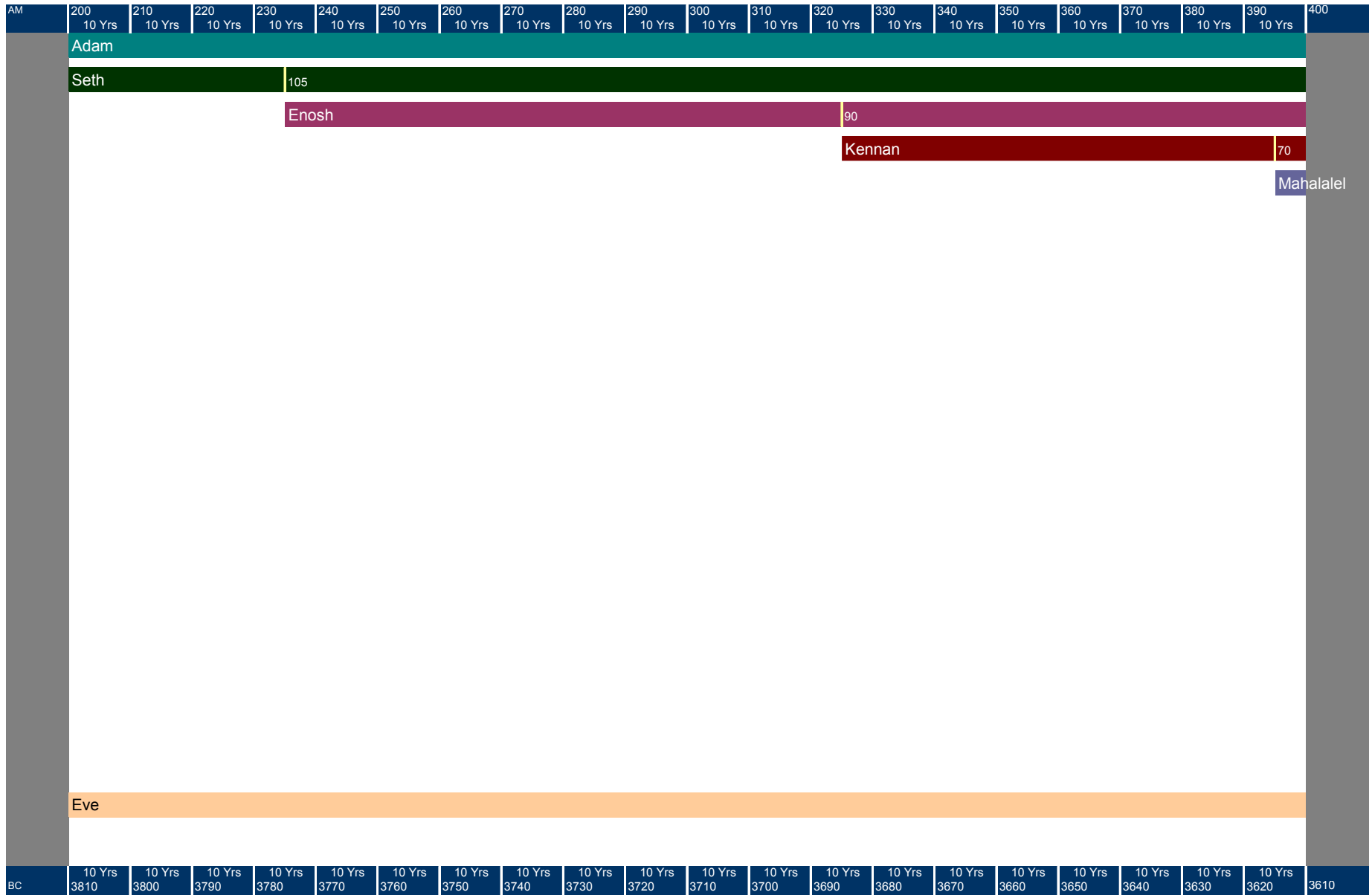
The last three pages of the timeline appear to be blank; this is because I have not documented the succession of Kings through the Greek and Roman Empires. To calculate the time to Christ we only need to know the date when the decree to rebuild Jerusalem was given, and then how many years there are from that date until the death of Christ in 32AD (see Chapter 8 – Daniels 70 Week Prophecy for more details).

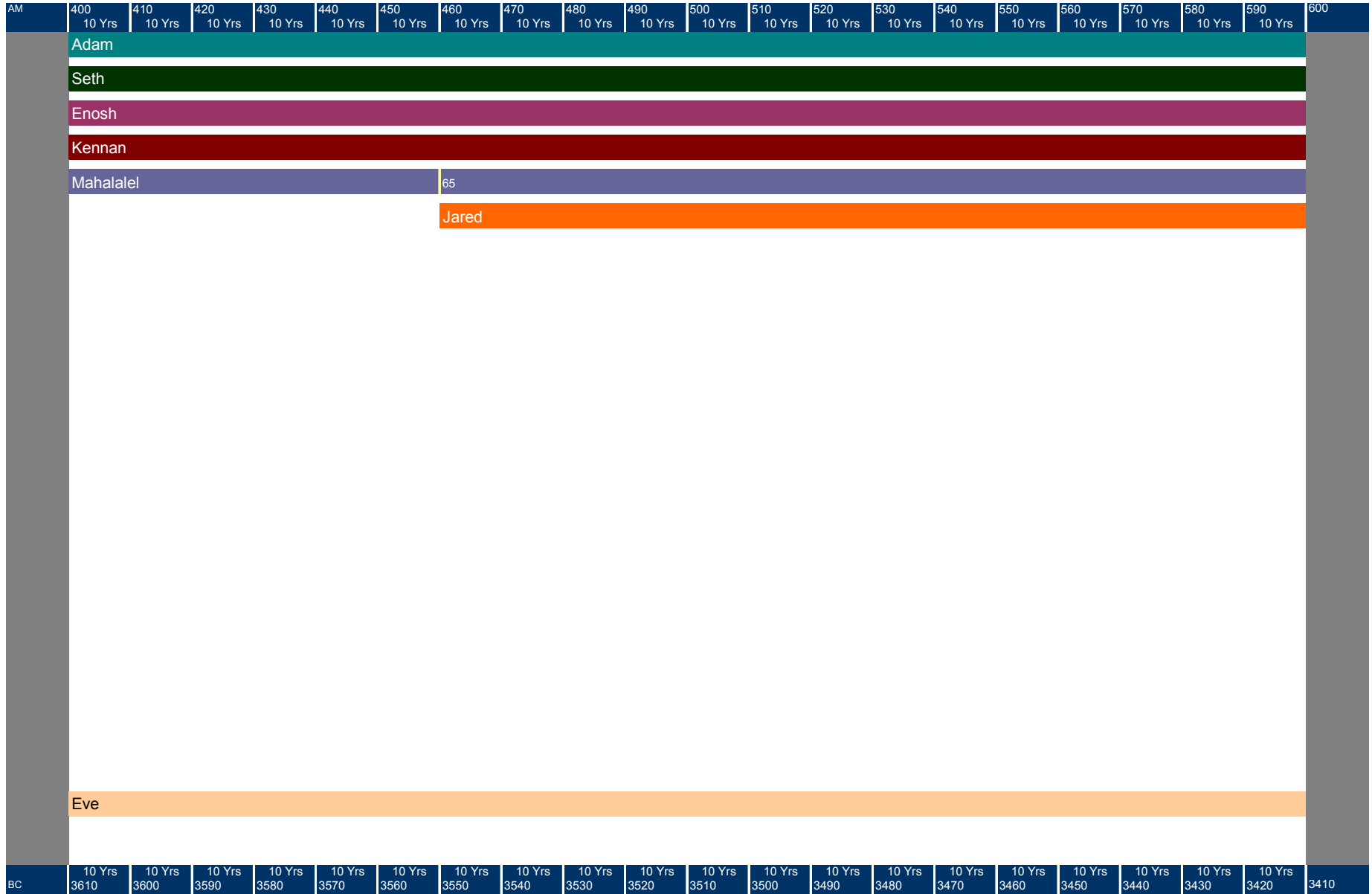

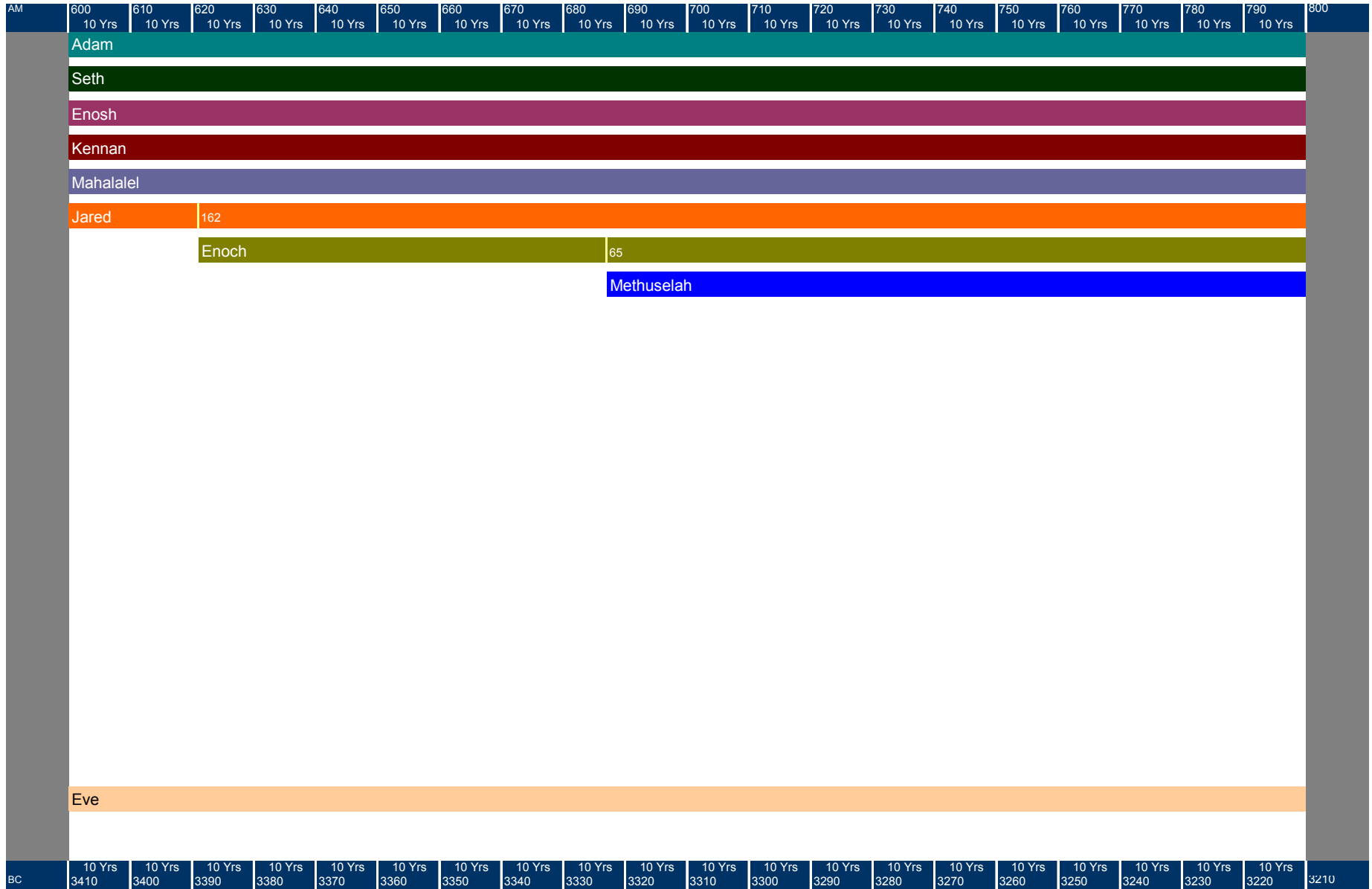
Timeline from 4010BC to 3810BC



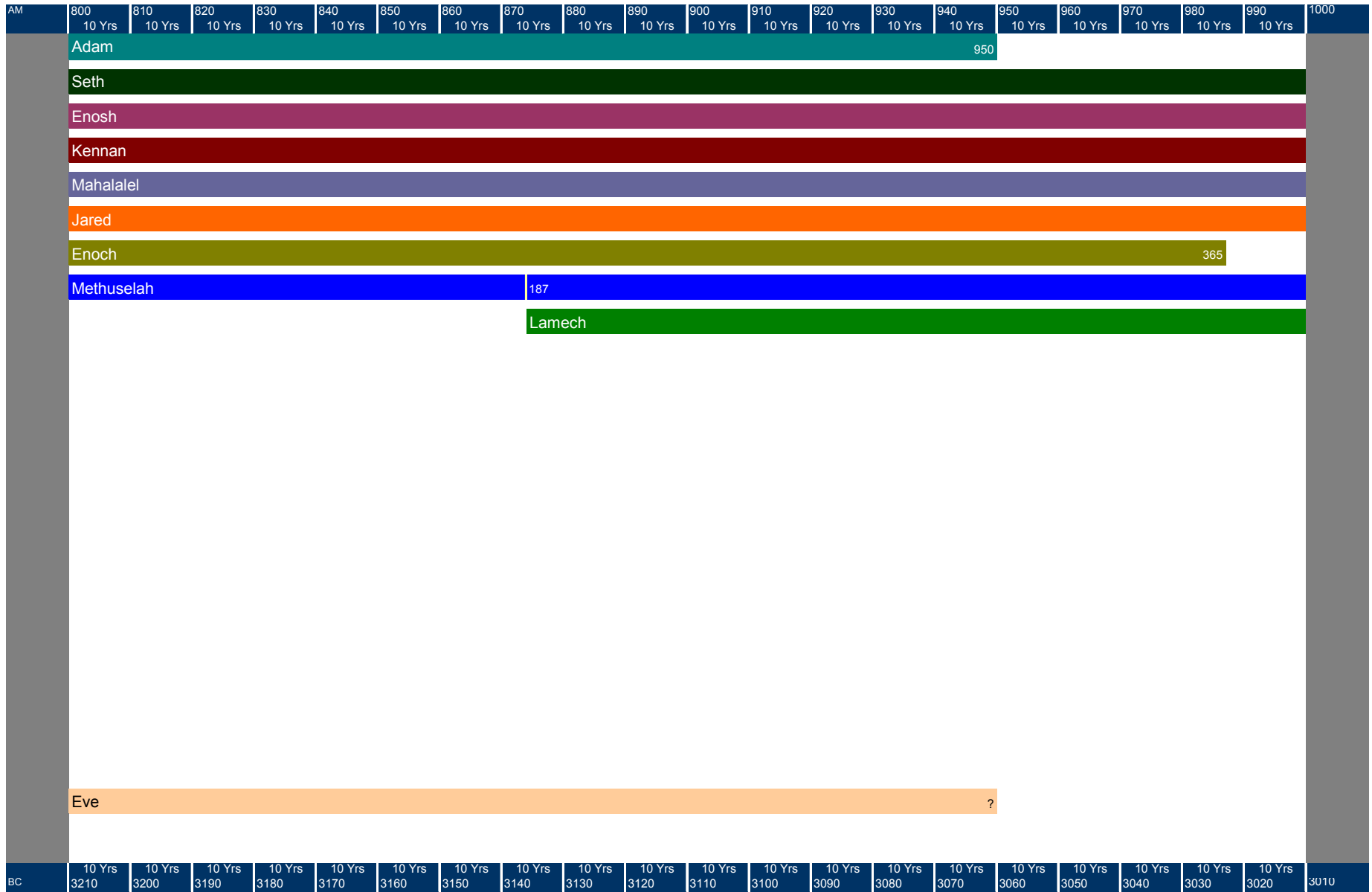
Timeline from 3810BC to 3610BC



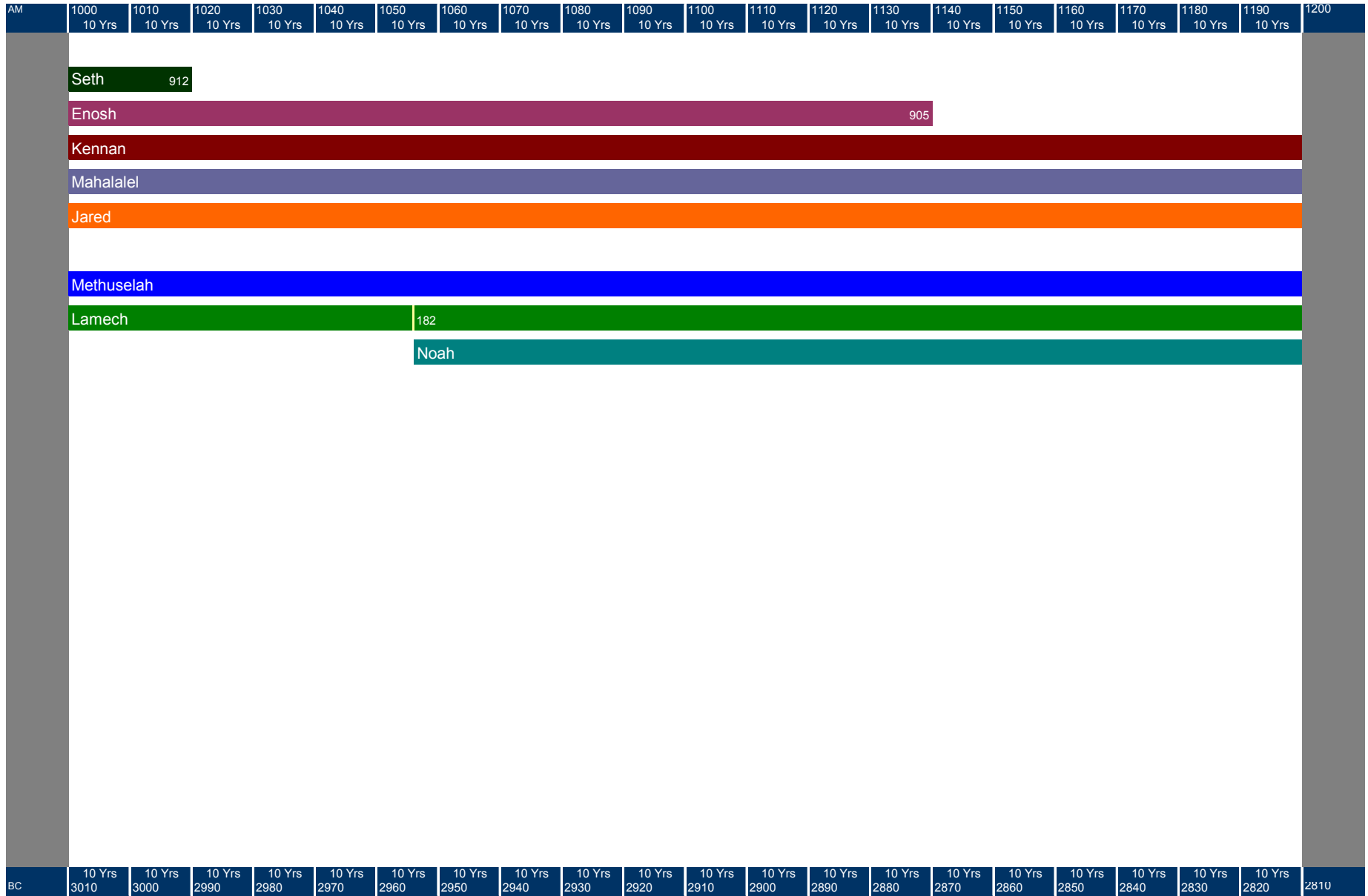
Timeline from 3610BC to 3410BC



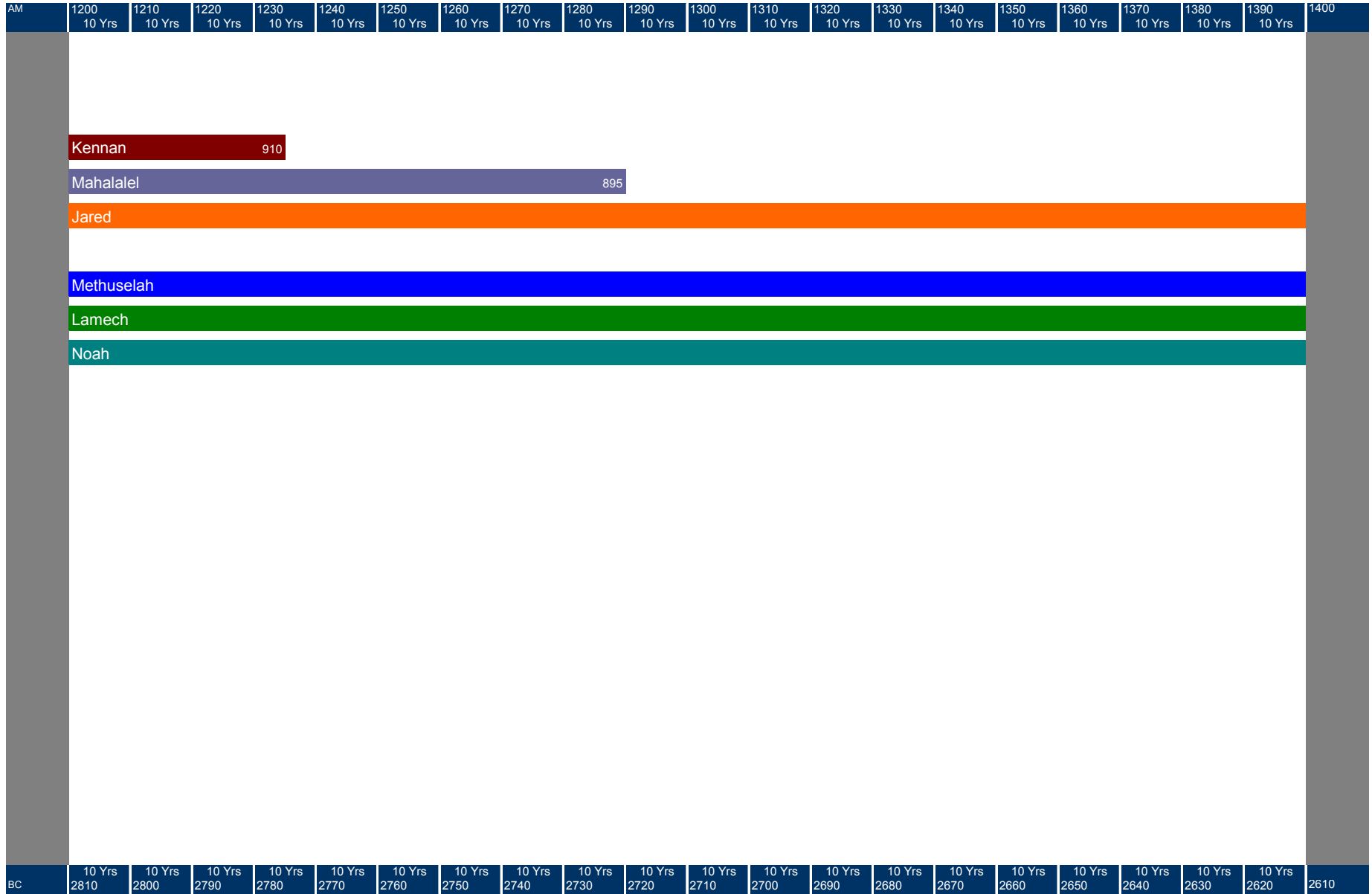
Timeline from 3410BC to 3210BC



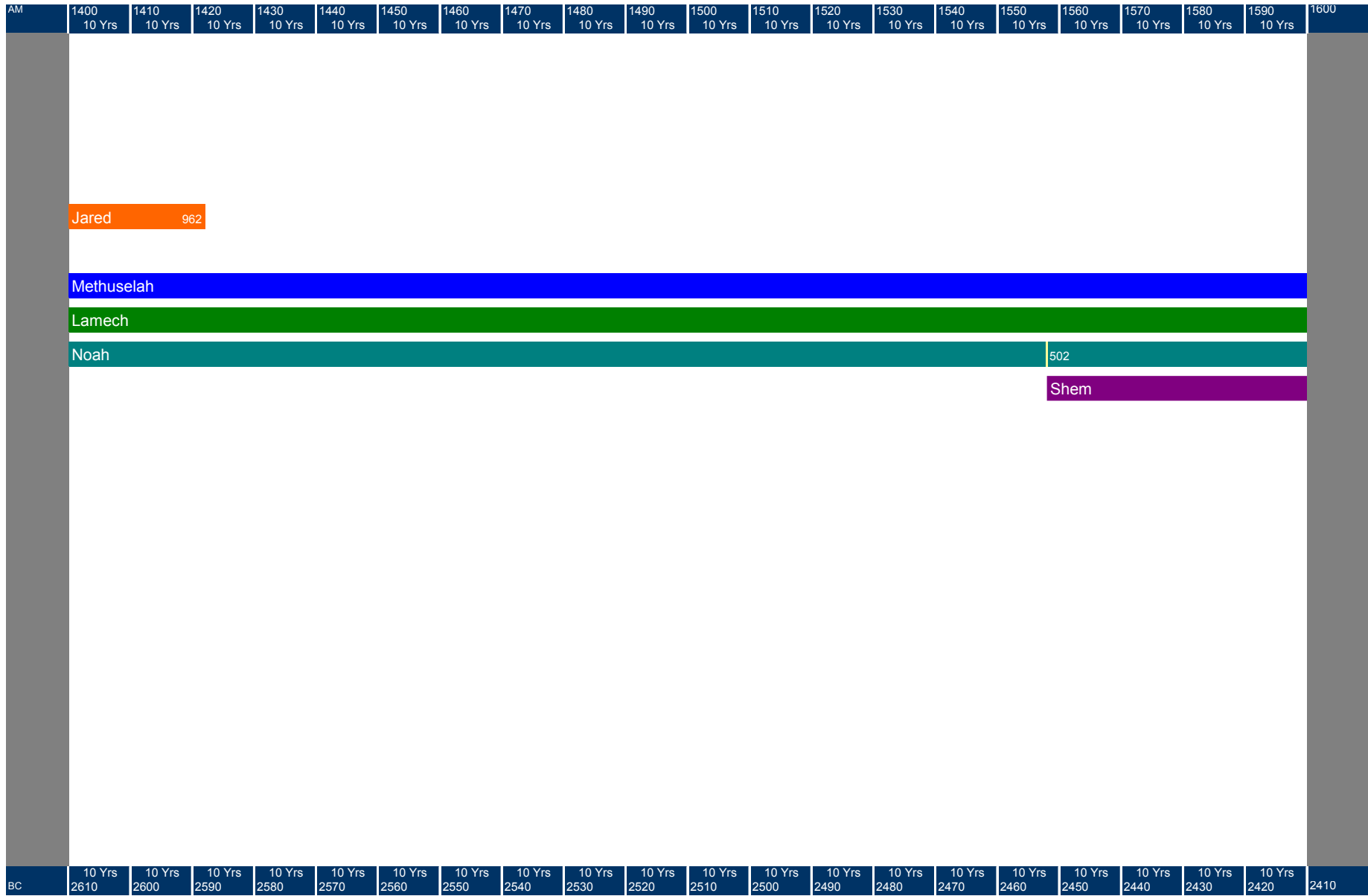
Timeline from 3210BC to 3010BC



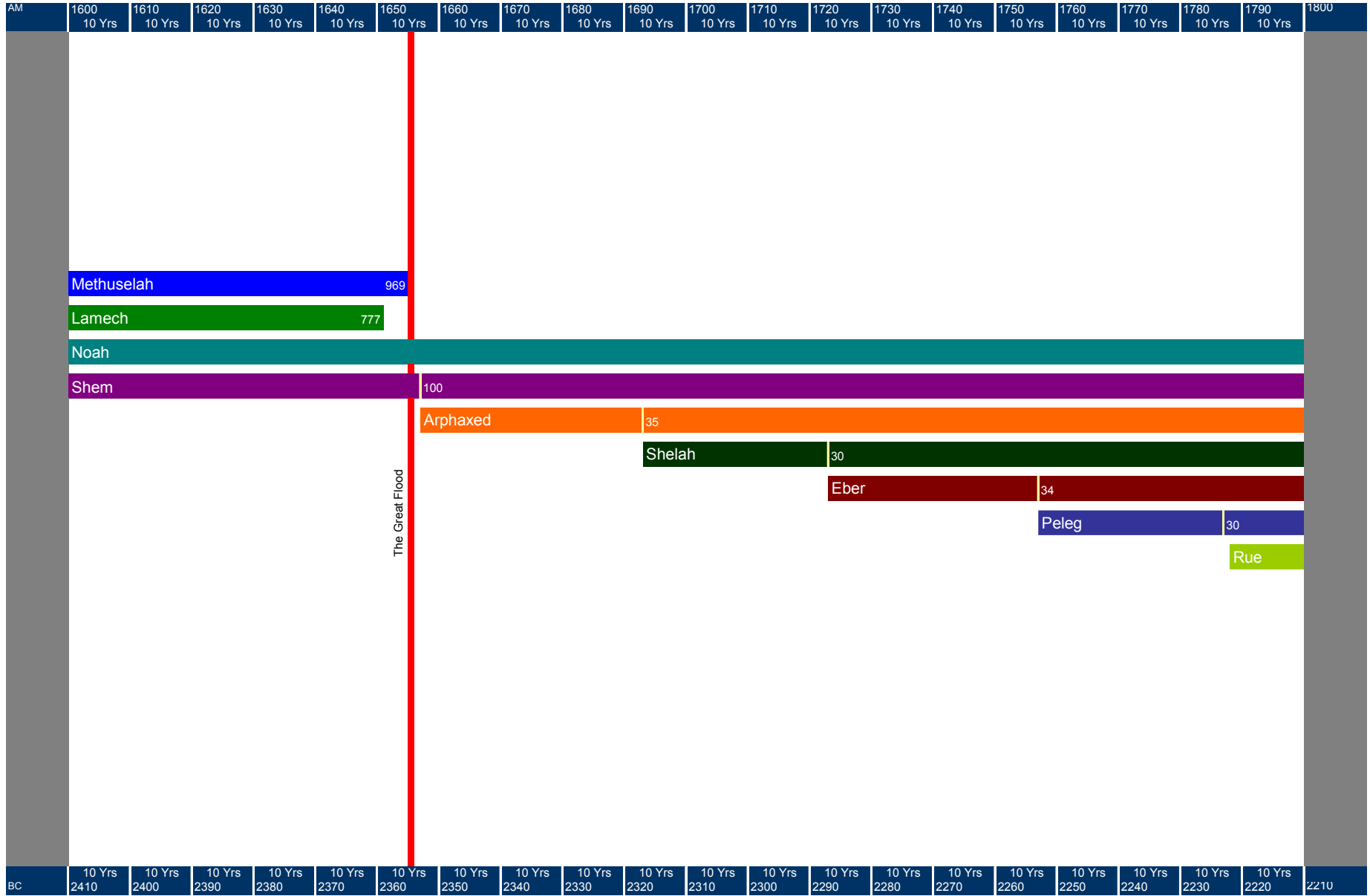
Timeline from 3010BC to 2810BC



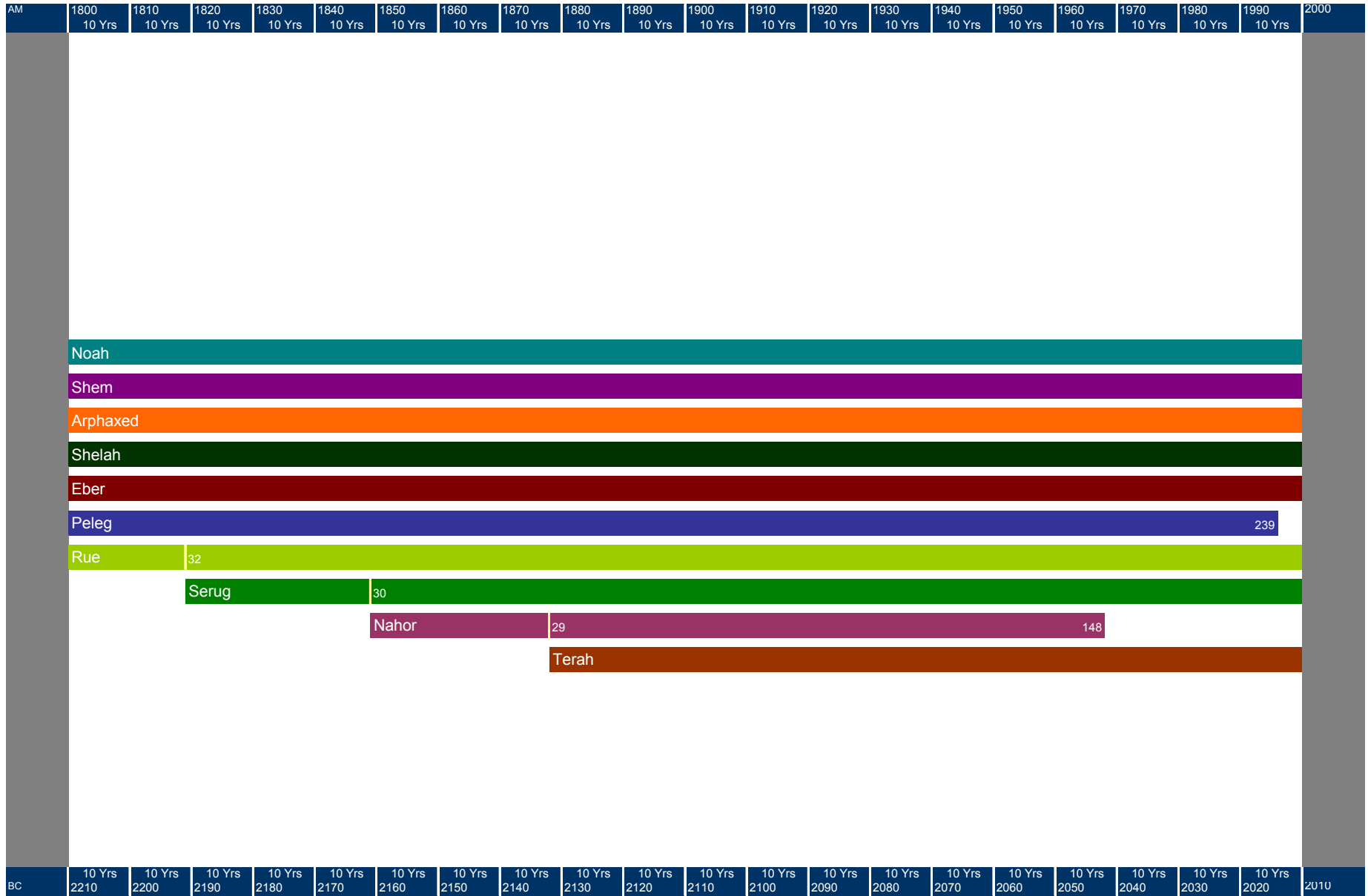
Timeline from 2810BC to 2610BC



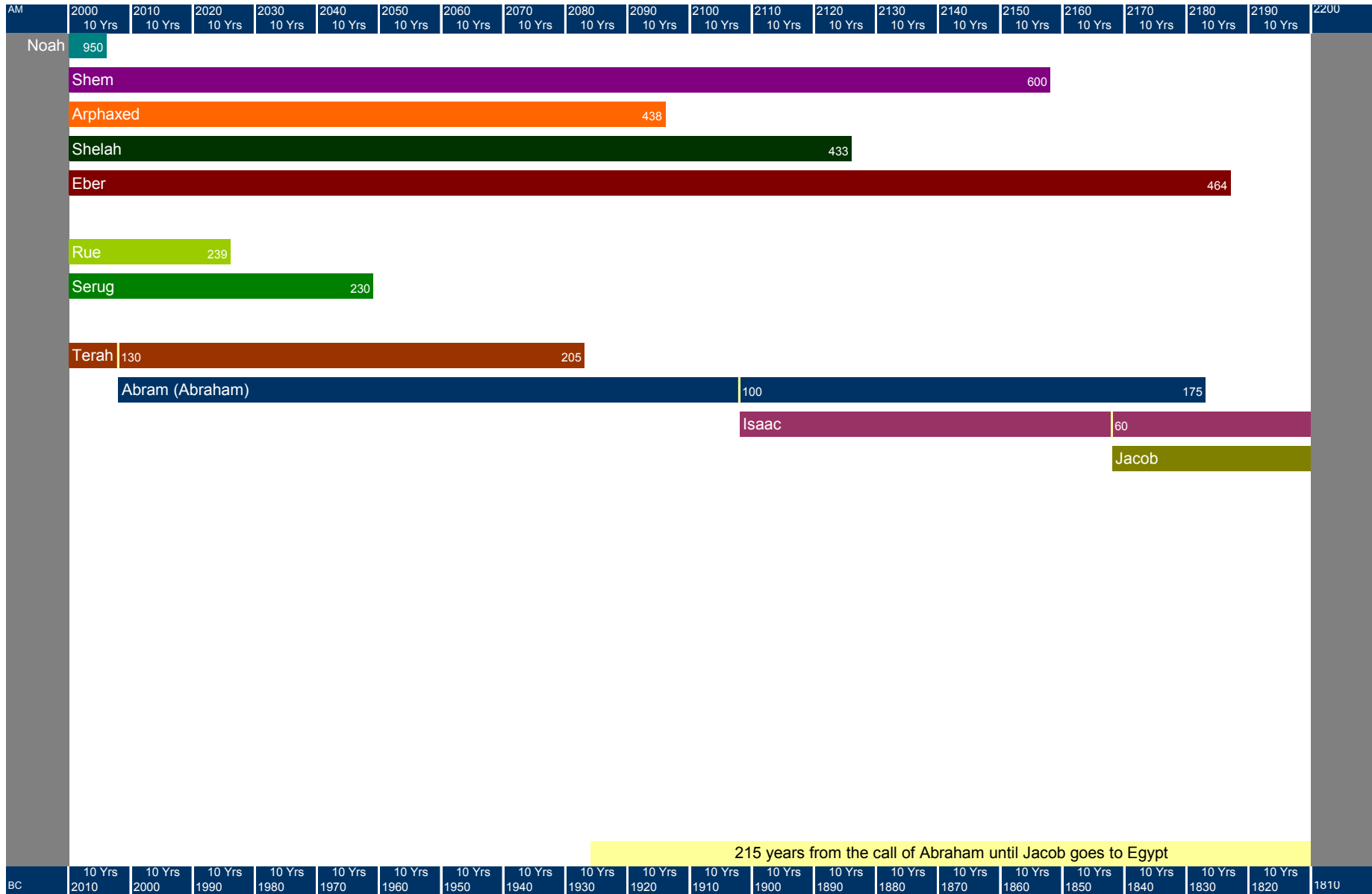
Timeline from 2610BC to 2410BC



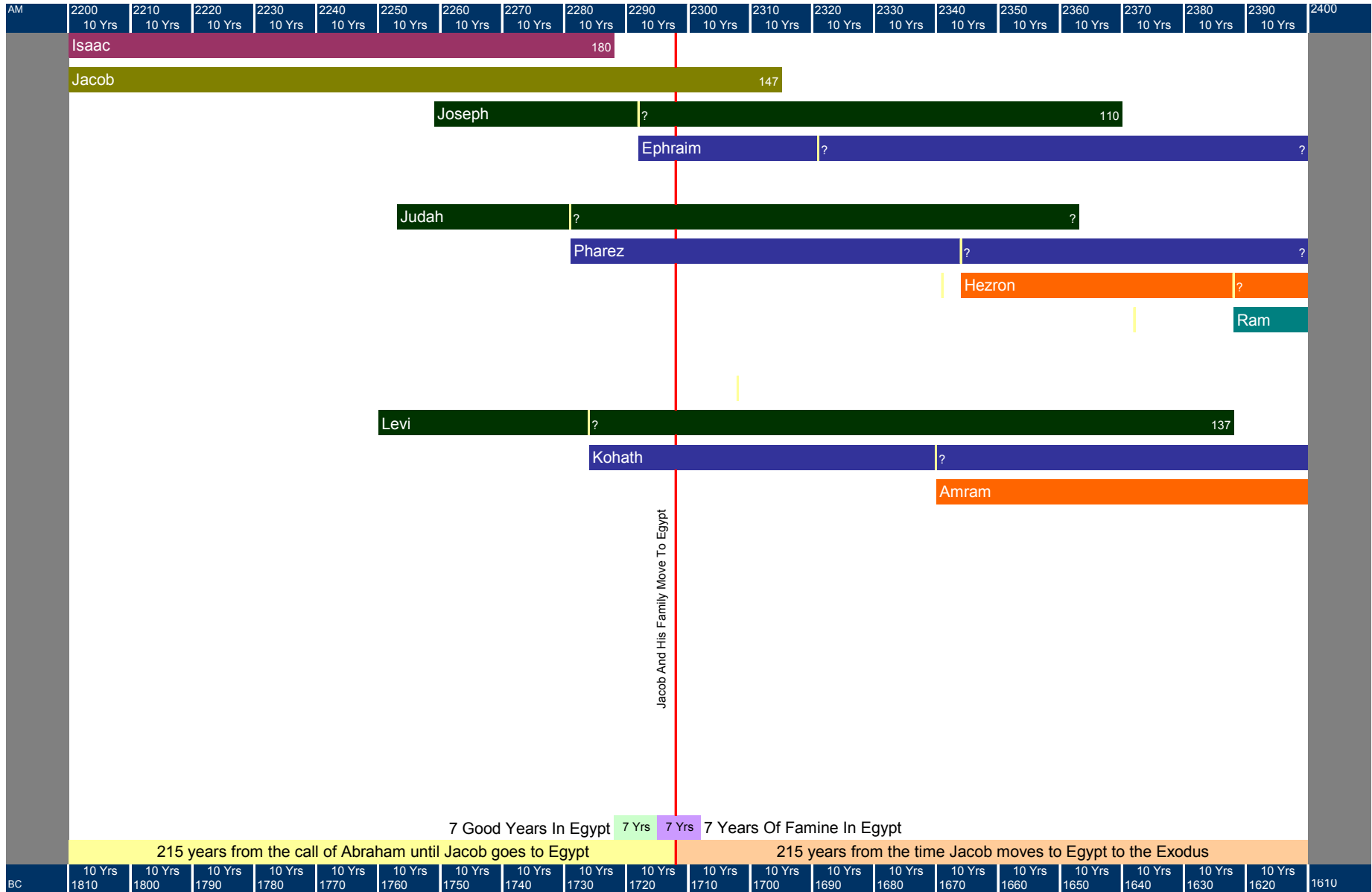
Timeline from 2410BC to 2210BC



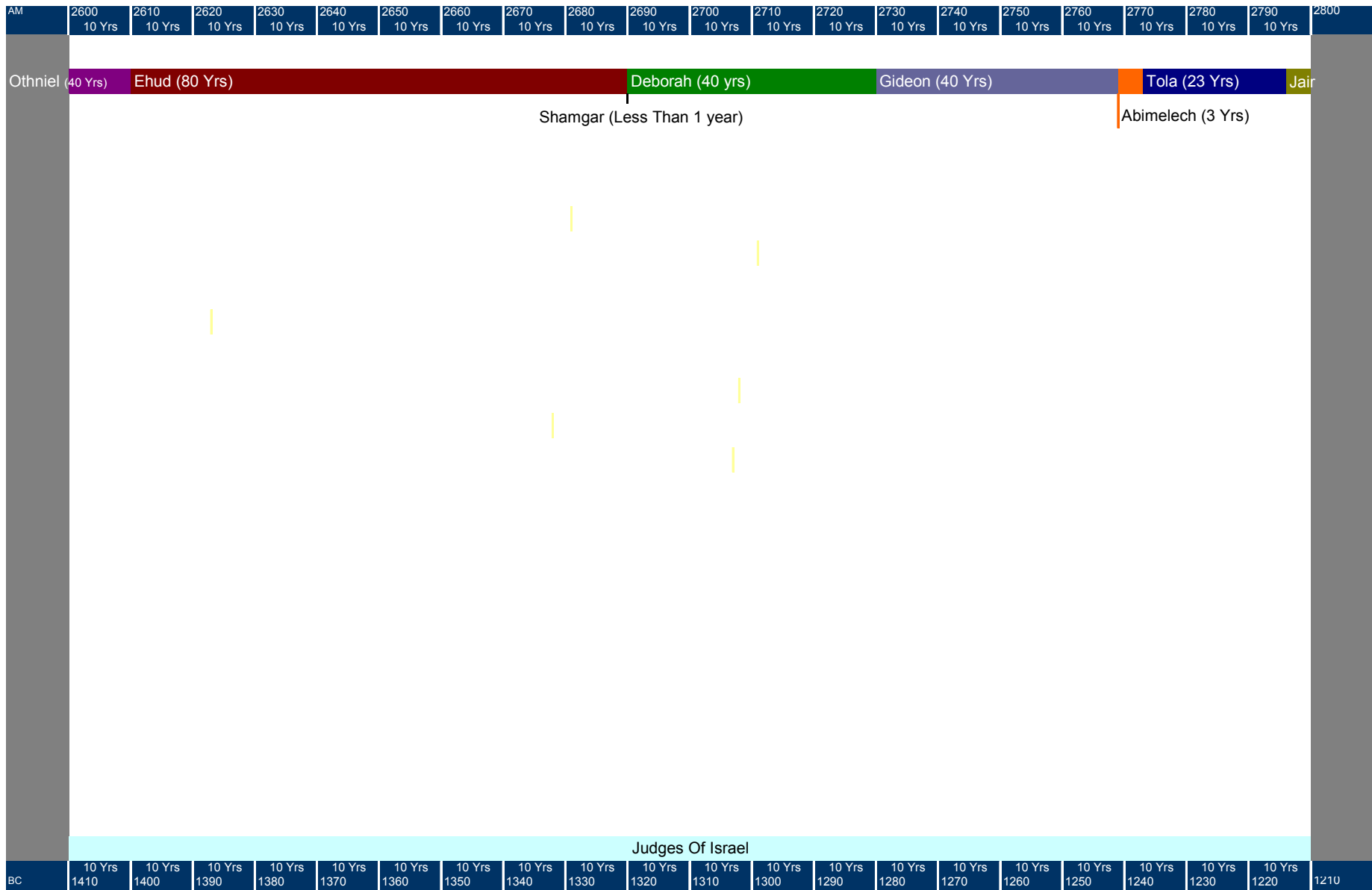
Timeline from 2210BC to 2010BC



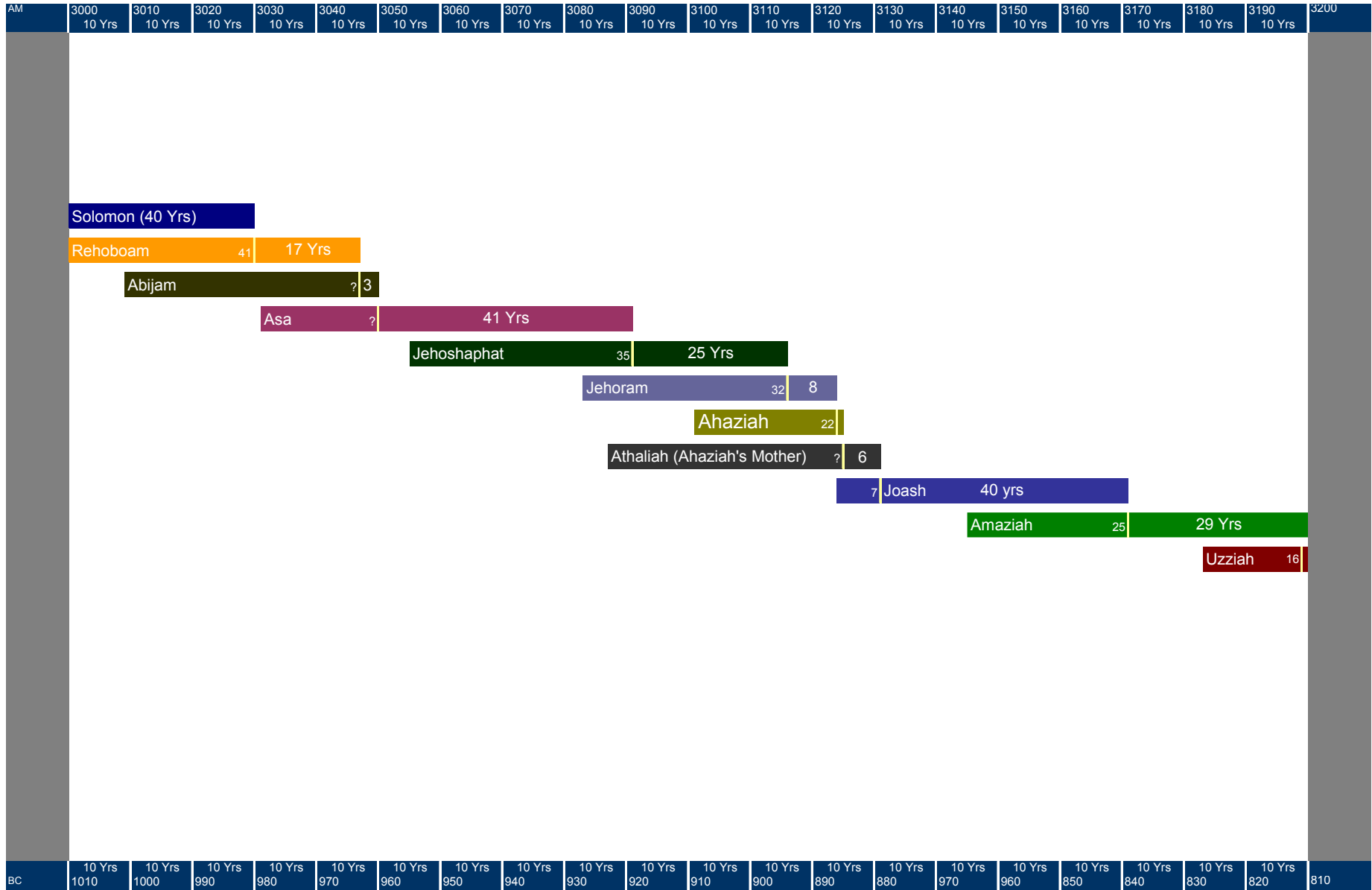
Timeline from 2100BC to 1810BC



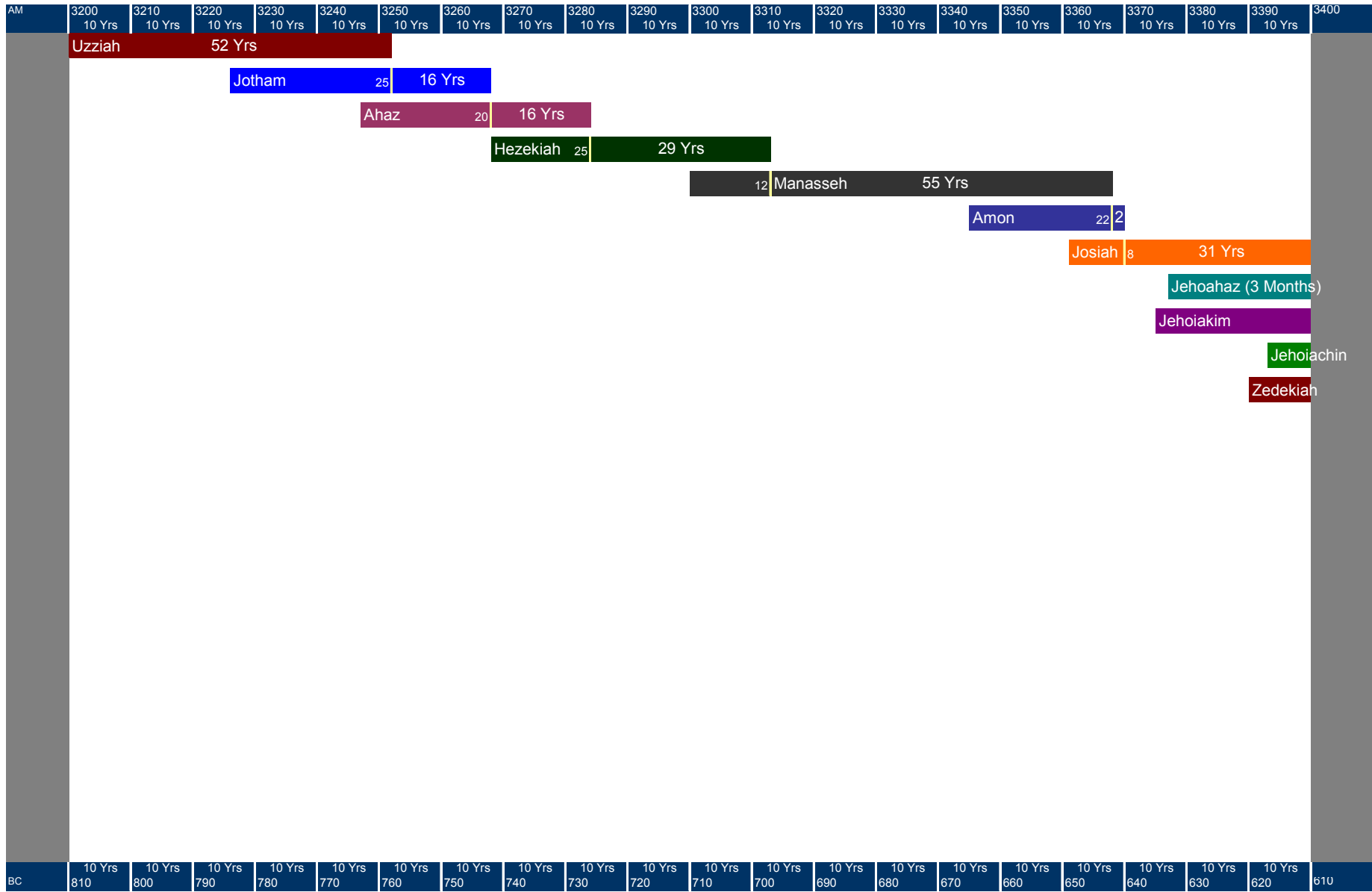
Timeline from 1810BC to 1610BC



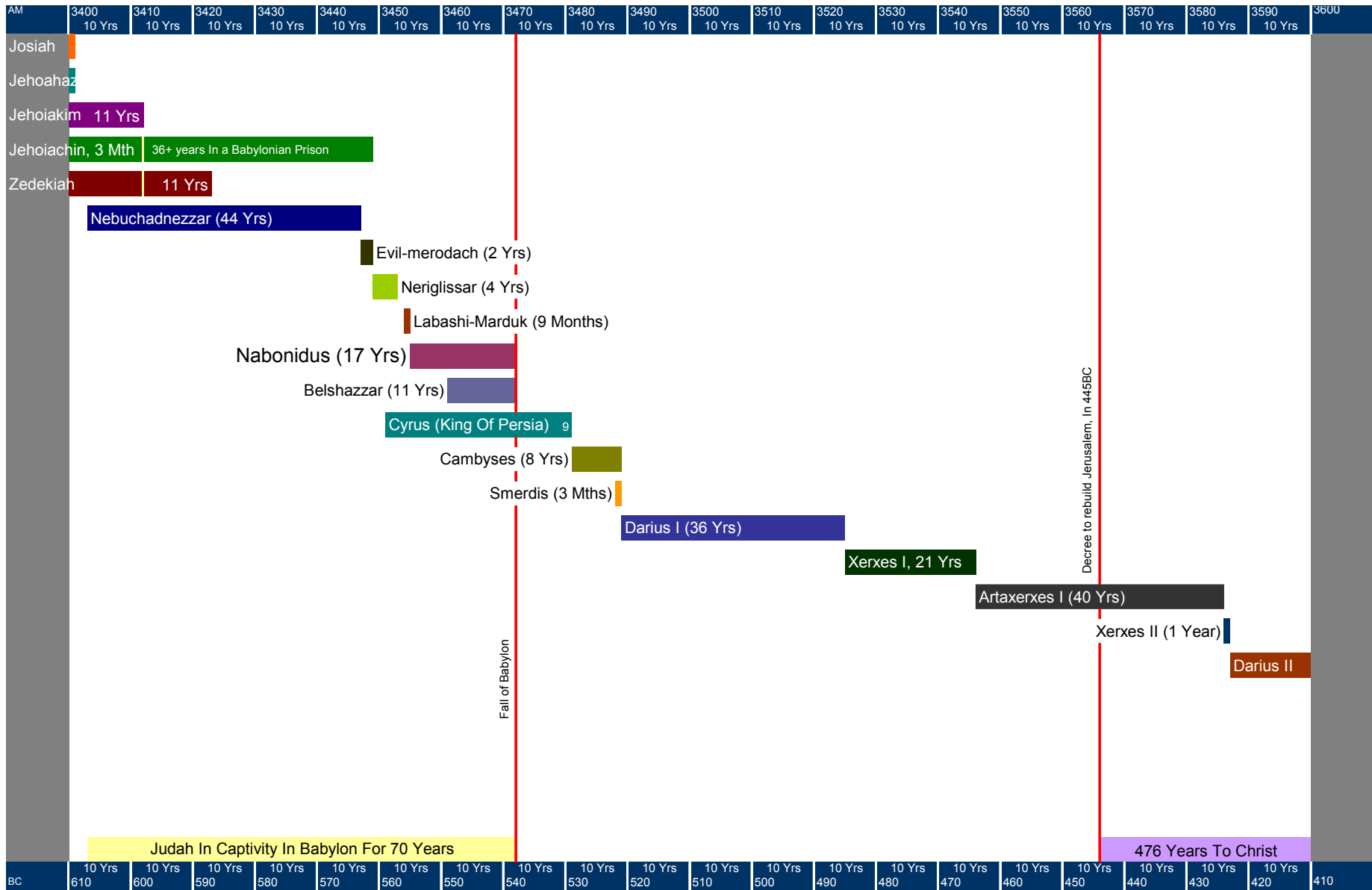
Timeline from 1410BC to 1210BC



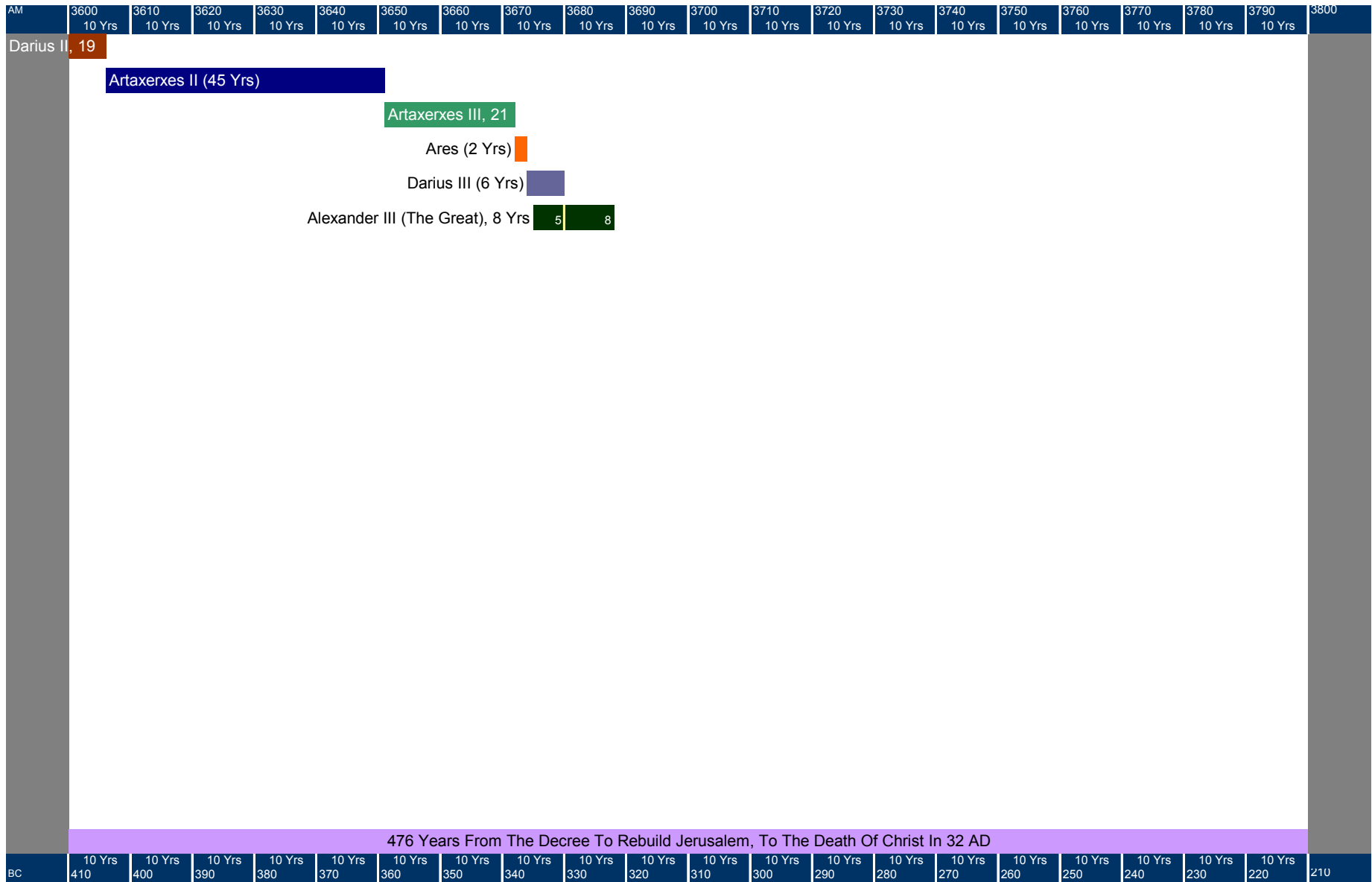
Timeline from 1010BC to 810BC



Timeline from 810BC to 610BC



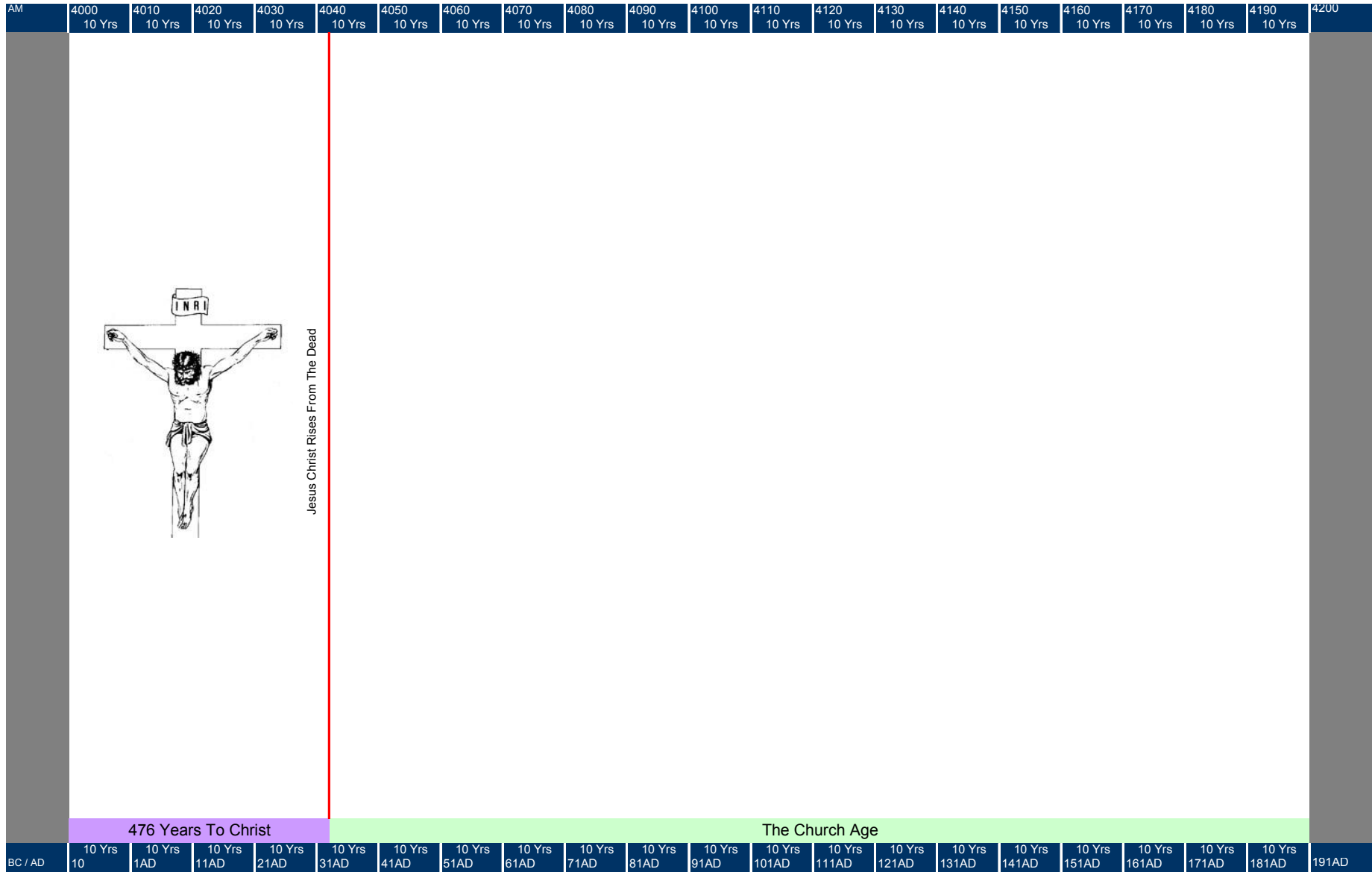
Timeline from 610BC to 410BC
